

## Transport

Moscow has three main airports.

Sheremetyevo International Airport, **SVO**, is 32km northwest of the centre of Moscow, in the city of Khimki. List of airlines and more information are available in the link: <http://www.svo.aero/en/airlines/>

Domodedovo International Airport, **DME**, is 45km southeast of the centre of Moscow. It carries slightly more passengers than Sheremetyevo International Airport on an annual basis. The airport is the base of international discount carrier S7. Other information is there: <http://www.dme.ru/en/>

Vnukovo International Airport, **VKO**, is 30km southwest from the centre of Moscow, <http://www.vnukovo.ru/en/>


Organizing Committee will organize airport transfers. Independently you can order a taxi. Estimated cost of taxi from the airports is 50–70\$ (USD), the official taxi are yellow, with squares down. We recommend you to order taxi by some of Mobile apps: Uber or RuTaxi. RuTaxi is a cheapest app, estimated cost of airport transfer is 15–30\$ (USD). It is available as a web-service.

There are the direct trains (Aero express trains) from Moscow airports to Moscow railway stations. Journey time is approximately 30–40 minutes, fare is 500 rubles (slightly less than 10\$). You can go from railway stations to Moscow State University by taxi (about 15–20\$) or by the Moscow underground (metro).

Recommended hotels and MSU Shuvalovsky building are located near to the metro stations.

### Food

Within the same Moscow city block you can find both five-star fine dining and hot dog snack vans. Muscovites love going out, so most restaurants tend to fill up quickly. To be sure of getting a table, make sure to book in advance. Be aware that many restaurants morph into bars and clubs in the later hours of the evening, so make early reservations if you want some peace and quiet. Tipping is one Western tradition that Russians are making their own. Tip for good service only – around ten percent is considered fair.

The average breakfast price in Moscow is 5–15\$, lunch is 8–20\$; minimal dinner price is 12\$. You can choose any place for your meal in Moscow with Trip Advisor service.
